PLEASE NOTE: The Service Contractor must be registered with LCWSA in order to tap into LCWSA's Water System. If the Contractor is not yet registered, registration applications are available at the main office located at 380 Old Cement Road, Montoursville, PA 17754.

- ◆ **METERS and BACKFLOW PROTECTION DEVICES are REQUIRED and must be approved PRIOR to connection.**
- ◆ **CROSS CONNECTIONS TO AUXILIARY WATER SUPPLIES, SUCH AS WELLS, CISTERNS OR SPRINGS, ARE PROHIBITED.**

15. The Applicant must initial the statements presented below, then sign and date this application. The terms and conditions upon which this Application may be accepted by the Authority are as follows:

_____ The Applicant agrees to be bound by all the terms and conditions of this Application, and to pay the Authority for services at the Schedule of Rates in effect from time to time during the rendition of such services.

_____ That the Authority, by its representatives, shall have the right to enter the premises/facility at any reasonable time for the purpose of making such inspections as it may deem necessary, and it shall have the right to attach any testing device or use any means which it may elect to ascertain the condition of the pipe and appurtenances and the uses made of same.

_____ The service connection from the water main to the curb, including the valve box and control valve shall be maintained by the Authority; all other pipe fixtures and appurtenances shall be maintained in good condition by and at the expense of the Applicant.

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_____ The Applicant shall install at its expense, a double check valve detector assembly (DCDA) at such location as it may be determined by Authority. The DCDA shall as a minimum comply with the American Water Works Association (AWWA) Standard C510-07, or latest edition. The DCDA valve assembly is to be drilled and tapped to permit the installation of a 3/4-inch dual check valve approved by ANSI/ASSE Standard 1024 latest edition, isolation valves and fittings for a detector meter, all to be maintained by the Applicant subject to control by the Authority. Where a reduced pressure principle backflow prevention detector assembly (RPDA) is required, it shall as a minimum comply with AWWA Standard C511-07, or latest edition, and be fitted with a detector meter as described above.

_____ Said control valve shall be under the control of the Authority, except during times of fire, when it shall be under the control of the Chief of the Fire Department.

_____ That all fixtures and openings (other than the controlling valves) shall be kept closed and sealed, and not opened or used except during times of fire. Upon the extinguishment of each fire, the Applicant shall immediately notify the Authority, so that said fixtures and openings can again be closed and sealed.

_____ That the Applicant agrees the Authority shall not be considered in any manner an insurer of property or persons, or to have undertaken to extinguish fire, or to protect any persons or property against loss or damage by fire, or otherwise.

_____ That this Application does not contemplate uses of fixtures other than herein stated. If a supply of water for use other than extinguishment of fire is desired by the Applicant, then same shall be taken only through a service pipe separately connected with the water main of the Authority and not connected directly or indirectly with the service pipe contemplated by this Application. Any waste of water or use of water for purposes other than the extinguishment of fire through this connection shall be deemed a violation of the terms and conditions of this Application and the Rules and Regulations of the Authority.

_____ The Applicant agrees not to add any substance whatsoever to the fire protection system without prior written approval of Authority and further agrees to install and maintain the cross-connection control device specified by Authority to protect the potable water supply.

_____ That the Applicant shall furnish, attach and make a part hereof, an accurate sketch showing the pipes, valves, hydrants, tank openings and appurtenances contemplated in this Application. Such sketch must also show any other water supply system and pipelines and appurtenances which may exist on the premises. There shall be no connection between other supply and pipes connected to the Authority's mains.

_____ That the rights and obligations of the Applicant hereunder shall be further subject at all times to the Rates, Rules and Regulations of the Authority that now exist or which may hereafter be adopted.

_____ That the Applicant agrees to obtain in advance, the approval of the Authority for any change, alteration, addition or deduction contemplated in the fixtures, openings and uses herein specified.

_____ That upon acceptance by the Authority and the completion of the service connection herein contemplated, this Application shall be in force as a contract and shall continue as such until cancelled by written notice fifteen (15) days in advance given by the Applicant to the Authority.

_____ That the Authority has the right to discontinue or disconnect said service pipe and terminate this Application, upon written notice given thirty (30) days in advance by the Authority to the Applicant, for failure to pay any bill when due, or for any violation of any of the terms and conditions of this Application, or for any violation of its rules, and in emergencies also has the right without notice to shut off all or any part of it's facilities and discontinue the service when deemed necessary by the Authority for the purpose of making any repairs, alterations, additions, or to prevent possible contamination through cross-connected facilities of the Applicant or to prevent negligent or willful waste of water through the facilities of the Applicant.

_____ The acceptance of this Application by the Authority must be executed by its Executive Director before same becomes effective as a contract.

_____ The Applicant, its successors or assigns, agrees to indemnify and save the Authority harmless against any and all loss, damages, costs, expenses, claims, demands, suits, or other forms of liability that shall arise out of or by reason of the Applicant's repair, care, use or non-use of the fire protection system, pipes, valves, openings, fixtures and appurtenances.

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_____ The above Applicant does hereby apply for permission to make connection from the above property to the LCWSA's water system and hereby agrees to conform with all pertaining Rules, Regulations, Ordinances and Specifications and agrees to repair any damage to sidewalks, curbs and/or the property of others caused during the progress of the installation.

_____ The above Applicant acknowledges receipt of Tapping Fee Schedule, Drawings, Consumer Service Code, additional Applications or other pertinent forms for tapping of new water lines to Lycoming County Water and Sewer Authority Water System.

_____ The above Applicant is aware that 1-1/2" and 2" service lines must be installed with an adjustable flange.

_____ The Authority will provide inspection services to the Applicant at no charge for the first visit to the Applicant's property. For the second and any other subsequent site visits to the Applicant's property as a result of negligence by the Applicant or any representative of the Applicant (i.e., the Water Service Contractor), the Applicant will be billed a minimum charge of \$50 and will also be billed on an hourly basis at a rate of \$50 per hour for inspections lasting more than an hour prorated on a quarter hour basis. **A minimum 3 day notice must be given to the inspector when connecting to the public water system and for testing.**

_____ The Applicant and/or the Water Service Contractor retained by the Applicant acknowledge that before excavation begins, that the Pennsylvania One Call System must be notified at 1-800-242-1776.

_____ If the Applicant and/or the Water Service Contractor retained by the Applicant needs to use the LCWSA's rights-of-way, then such parties shall execute the LCWSA's agreement for temporary use of such Rights-Of-Way. The Property Owner and/or Service Lateral Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damage to the LCWSA's Rights-Of-Way, including but not limited to seeding, grading, curbs, sidewalks, etc.
