_____ The Authority will provide inspection services to the Property Owner at no charge for the first visit to the Owner's property. For the second and any other subsequent site visits to the Owner's property as a result of negligence by the Owner or any representative of the Owner (i.e., the Service Lateral Contractor), the Owner will be billed a minimum charge of \$50 and will also be billed on an hourly basis at a rate of \$50 per hour for inspections lasting more than an hour prorated on a quarter hour basis. **A minimum 24 hour notice must be given to the sewer inspector when the building sewer is connected to the public sewer system and ready for inspection/testing.**

_____ The Property Owner hereby acknowledges receipt of LCWSA's detailed Plans and Specifications for Grinder Pump installation and fully understands his/her responsibilities, to include the following:

- ◆ Owner is required to furnish and install a grinder pump at the owner's expense, including all necessary electrical and plumbing work.
- ◆ The grinder pump is the property of the Owner, who is responsible for the continued maintenance and satisfactory operation of the unit.
- ◆ The Owner covenants that he/she will appropriately inspects, maintain and otherwise ensure the satisfactory operation of the grinder pump, including, if necessary, the repair and/or replacement of the grinder pump, all at the Owner's sole cost. The Owner will also be solely responsible for the electrical or other energy costs necessary to operate the grinder pump.
- ◆ Owner shall further covenant that he/she will notify the Authority promptly upon discovery of any problem or defect in the operation of the grinder pump. The Owner will arrange promptly any necessary repair and/or replacement of the grinder pump. Any such planned repair or replacement will be subject to the Authority's advance approval in order to assure that it is consistent with the appropriate operation with respect to that particular property. The Authority may maintain an inventory of certain spare pump parts, but cost of repairs, including Authority-supplied spare parts, will remain the Owners' responsibility.

_____ The Property Owner hereby indemnifies the Authority from any and all damages that may result from the Property Owner choosing not to install a running trap.

_____ The Property Owner hereby indemnifies the Authority from any and all damages that may result from the Property Owner choosing not to encase a sewer lateral which is located within a horizontal distance of less than 50 feet from a water well.

_____ The Property Owner hereby acknowledges that 4-inch gravity sewer service lateral pipe from the structure to the Grinder Pump is acceptable, but that 6-inch pipe is recommended. Certain properties will have to utilize 6-inch pipe due to minimum slope requirements. SDR 35 pipe is required for gravity sewer lines and 1-1/4" or 1-1/2" HDPE pipe is required for pressure lines.

_____ The Property Owner and/or the Service Lateral Contractor retained by the Property Owner acknowledge that before excavation begins, that the Pennsylvania One Call System must be notified at 1-800-242-1776.

_____ If the Property Owner and/or the Service Lateral Contractor retained by the Property Owner needs to use the LCWSA's rights-of-way, then such parties shall execute the LCWSA's agreement for temporary use of such Rights-Of-Way. The Property Owner and/or Service Lateral Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damage to the LCWSA's Rights-Of-Way, including but not limited to seeding, grading, curbs, sidewalks, etc.

_____ The Property Owner and/or Authorized Representative understand that sewer billing will begin the 1st of the month following connection. Property owner will be responsible for all sewer charges incurred at above property.

The above Property Owner does hereby apply for permission to make connection from the above property to the LCWSA's sanitary sewer system and agrees to conform with all Rules, Regulations, Ordinances and Specifications pertaining to the sanitary sewer and to repair any damage to sidewalks, curbs and/or the property of others caused during the progress of the installation.
